ICA-SHEATH lays flat on the wall providing an exceptionally

smooth surface and can be ordered perforated for breatheability. ICA-SHEATH is extremely durable and is easily installed with common hand tools. Economical and efficient when installed properly, ICA-SHEATH will help to conserve energy by allowing your heating and cooling systems to operate more effectively.
